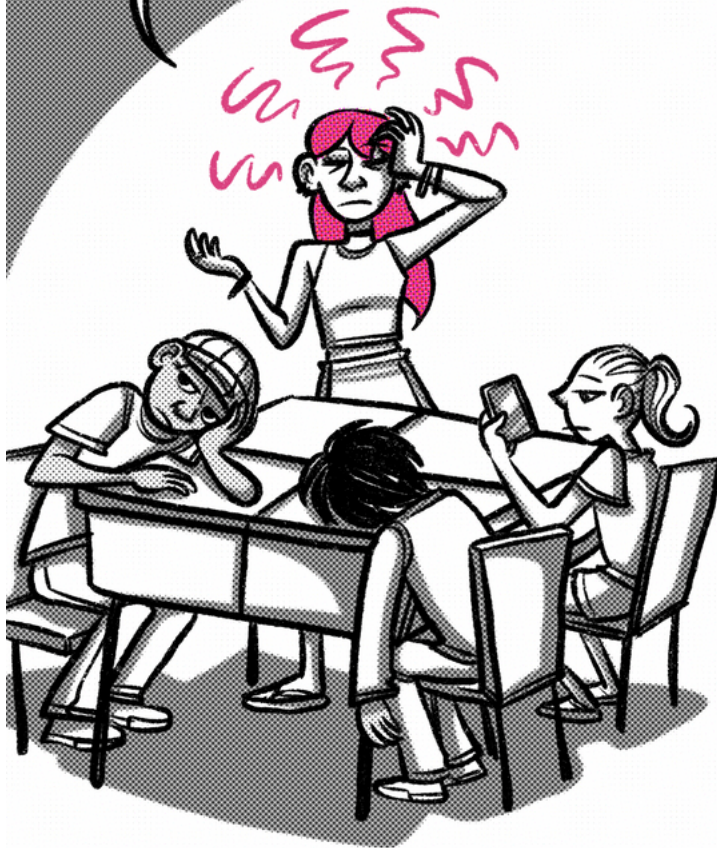


Y'know when you get assigned to a group project and no one seems to be able to get anything done?

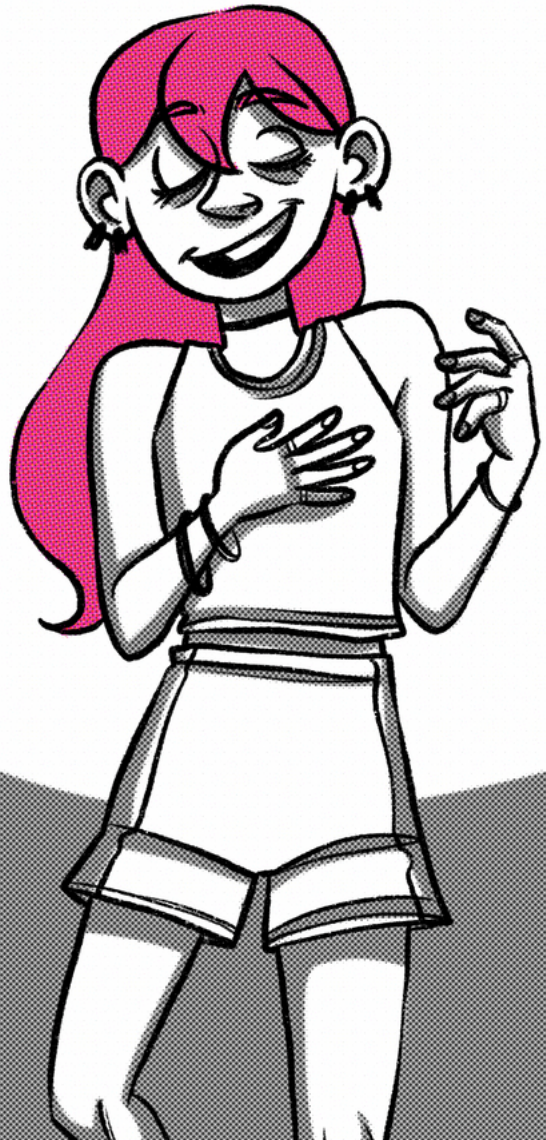

about y'know?

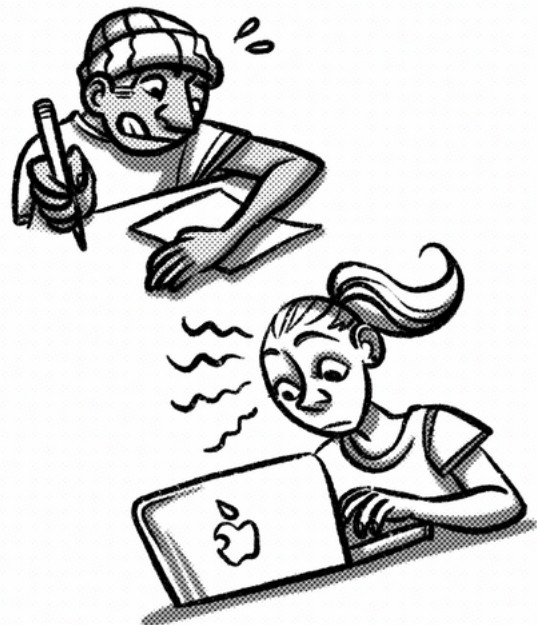
"This stuff all has

yourself, obviously).

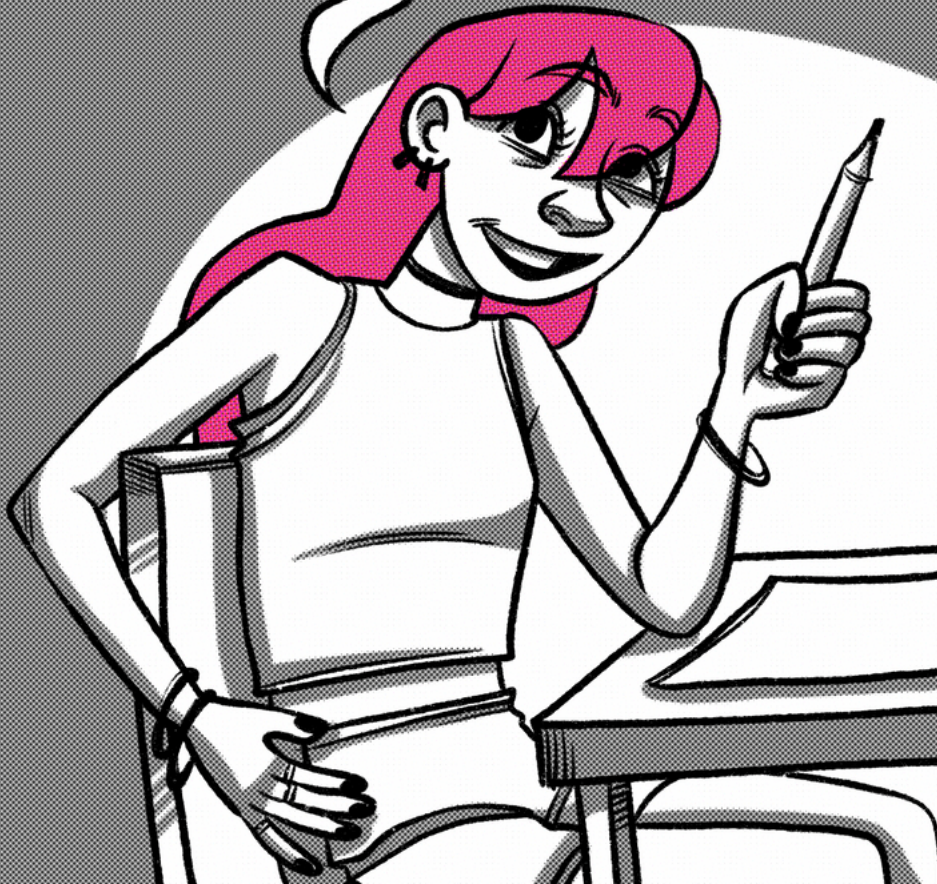


If people in your group are good at self-regulating + getting their list done, your job as "leader" may be finished.
